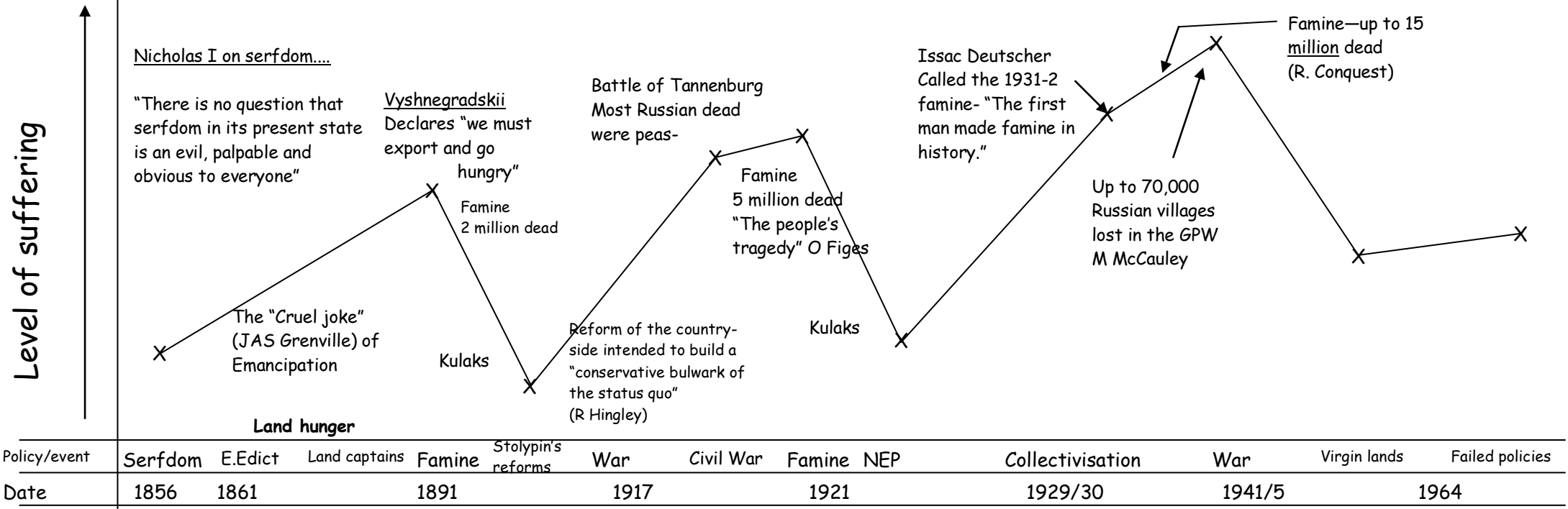


Russian Agriculture 1855-1964
