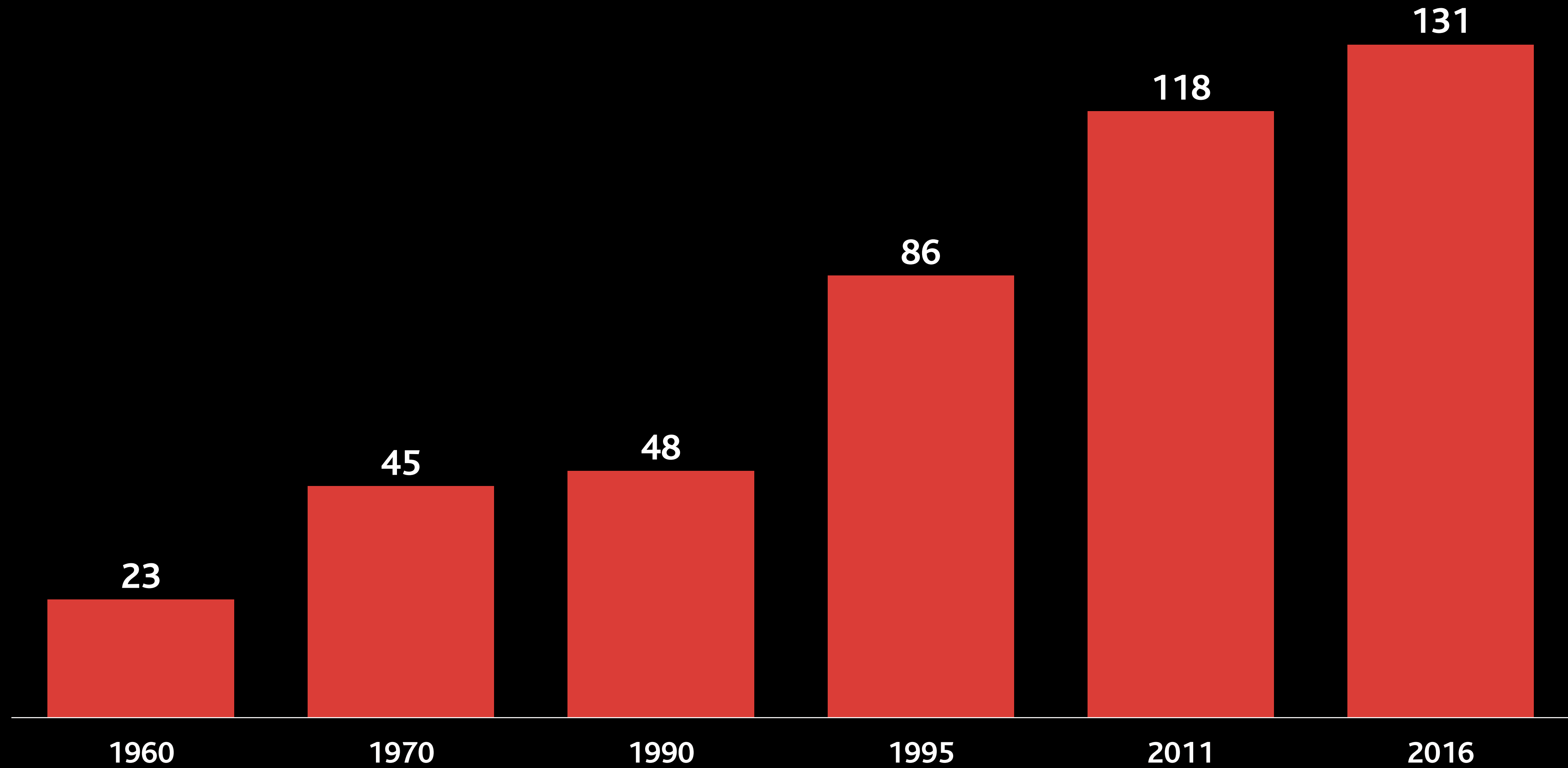

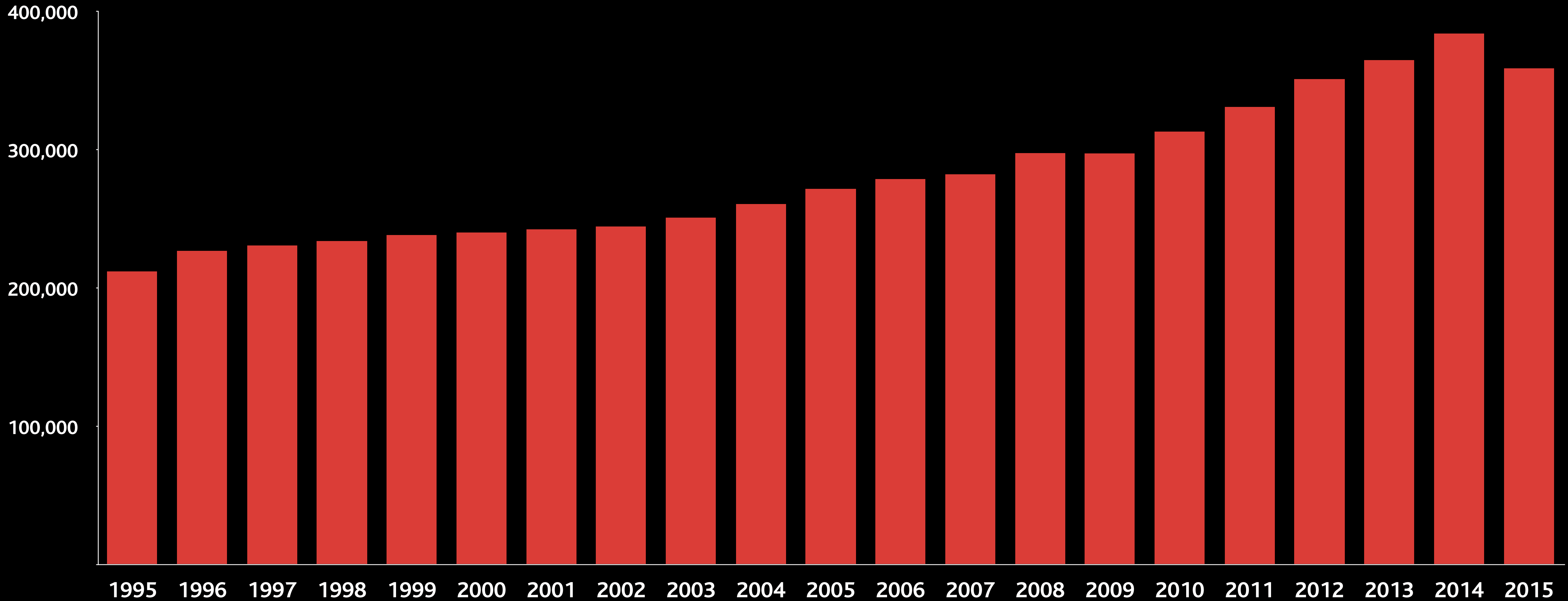

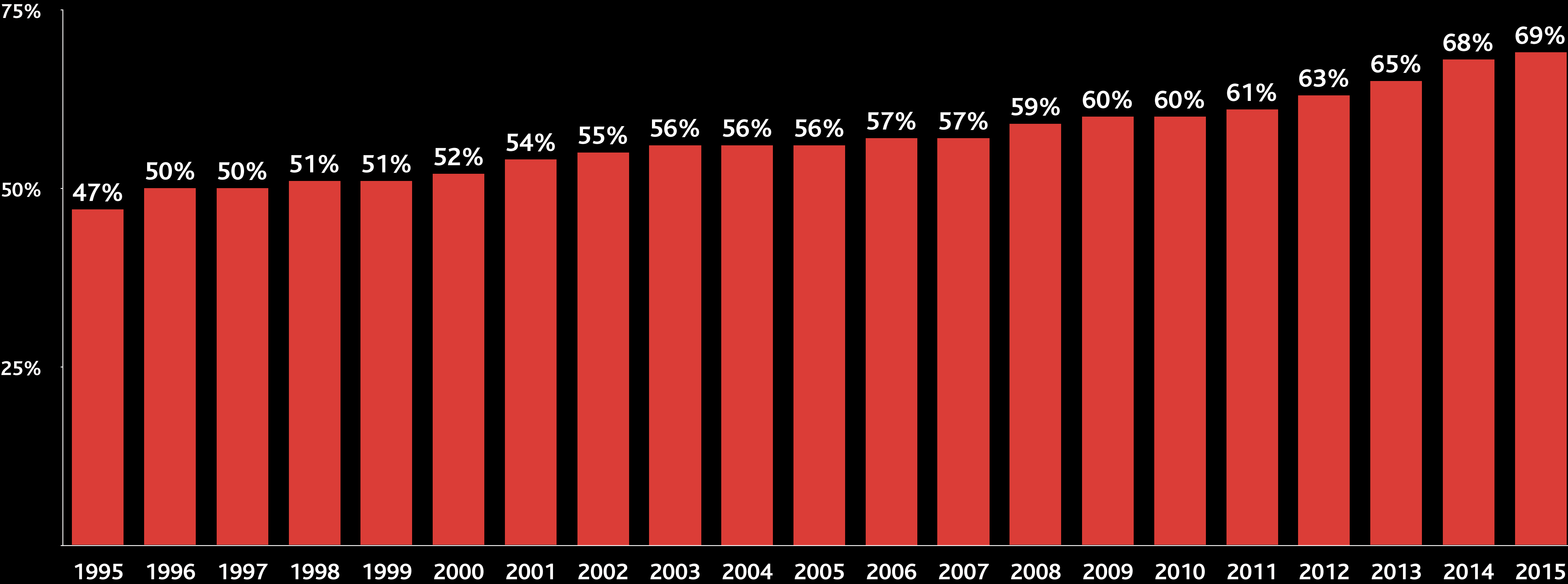

Graduates who Achieved a 1st or 2.1 Degree 1995-2015

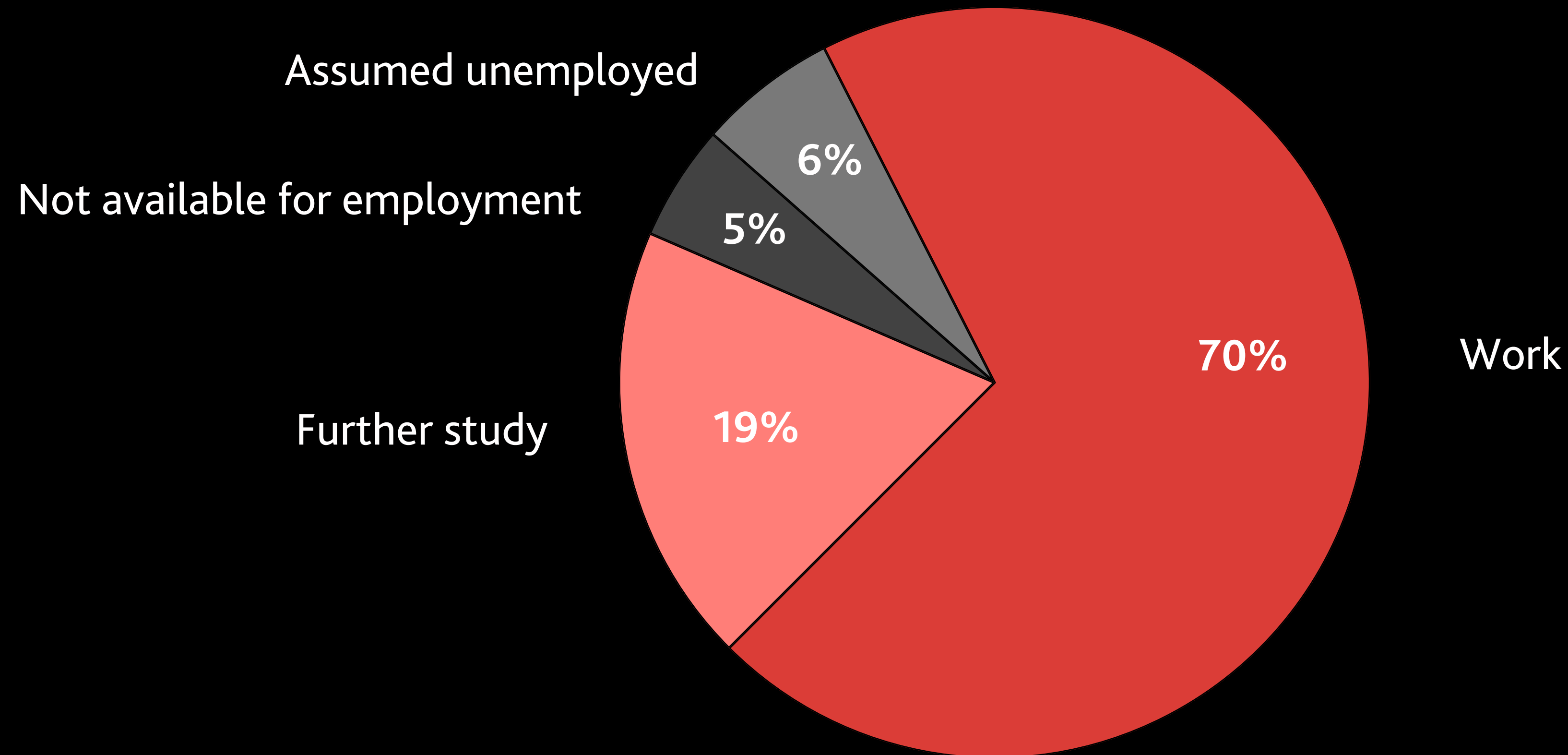

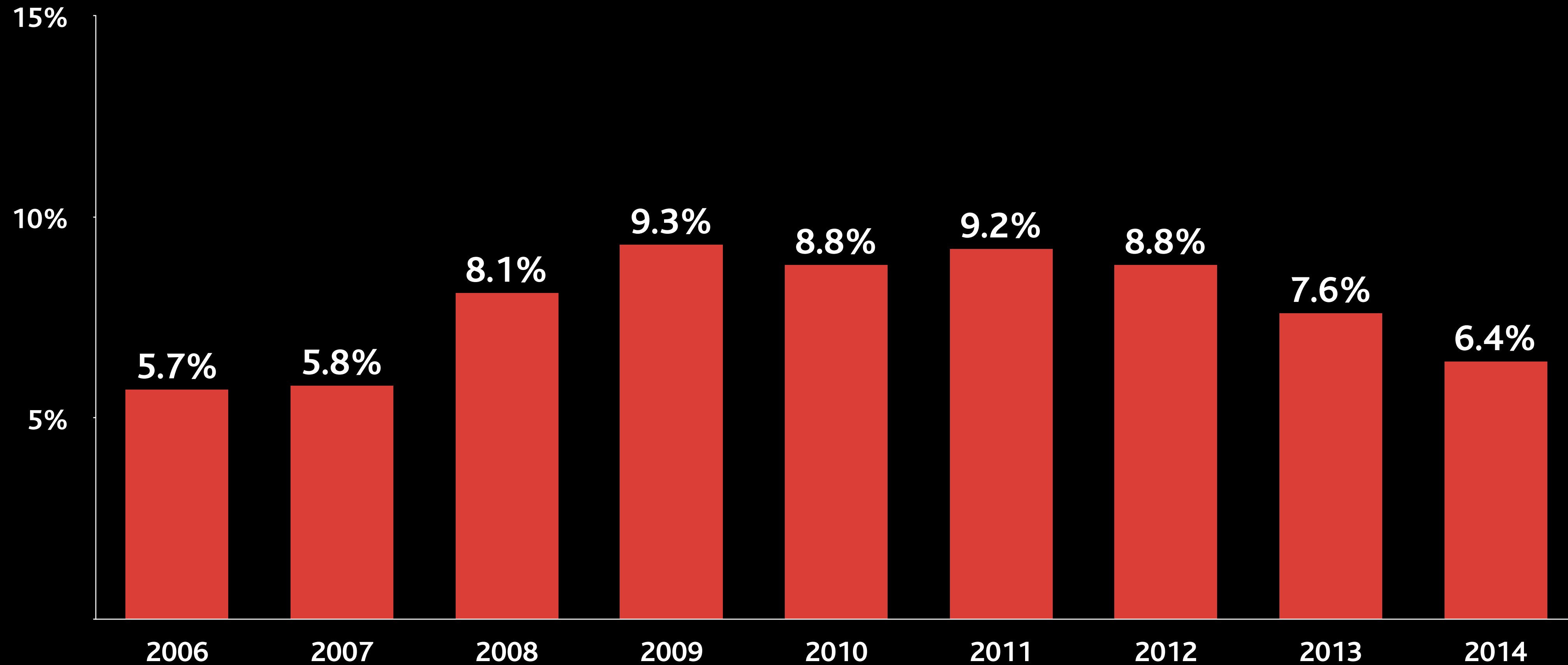

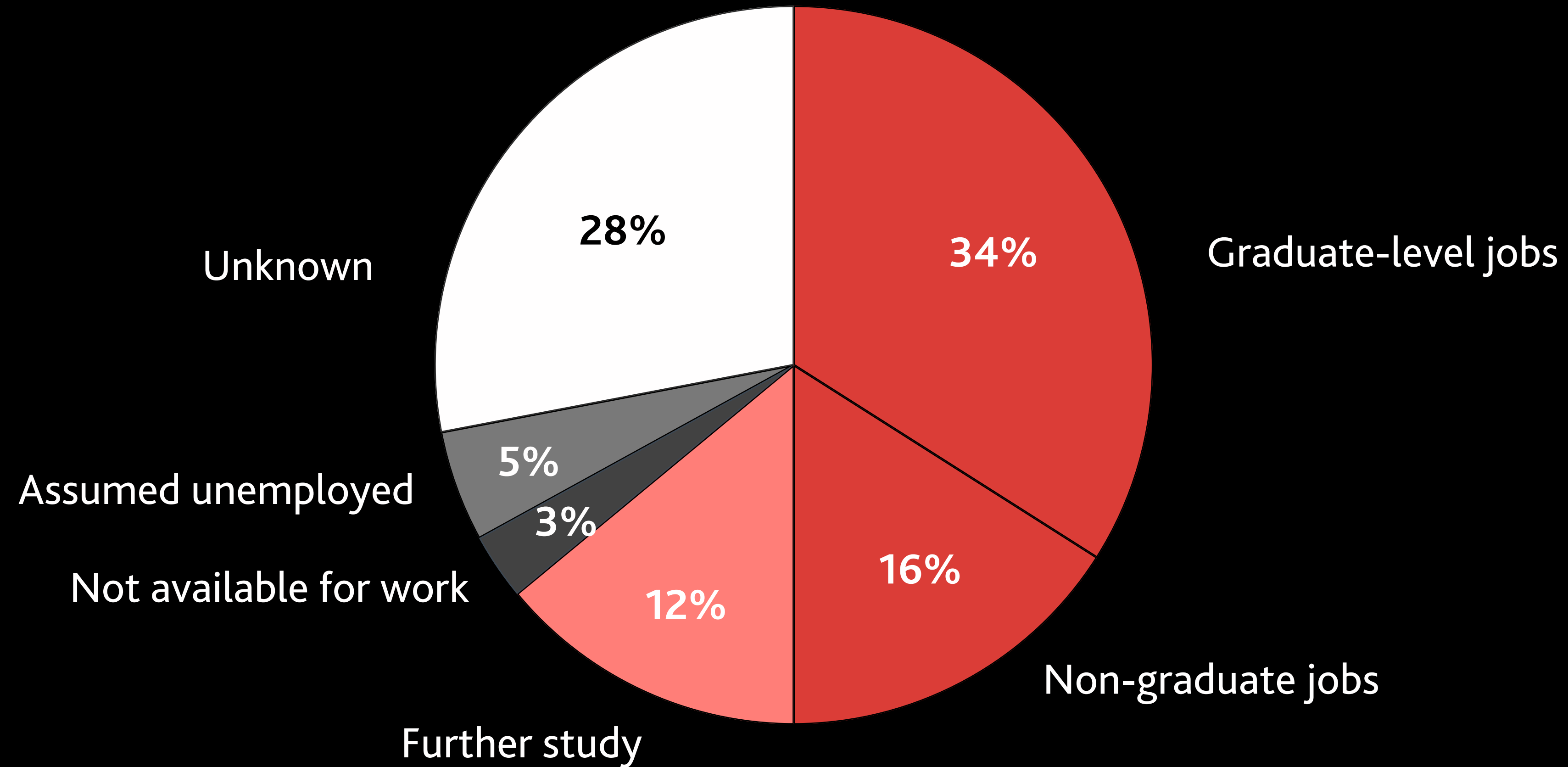

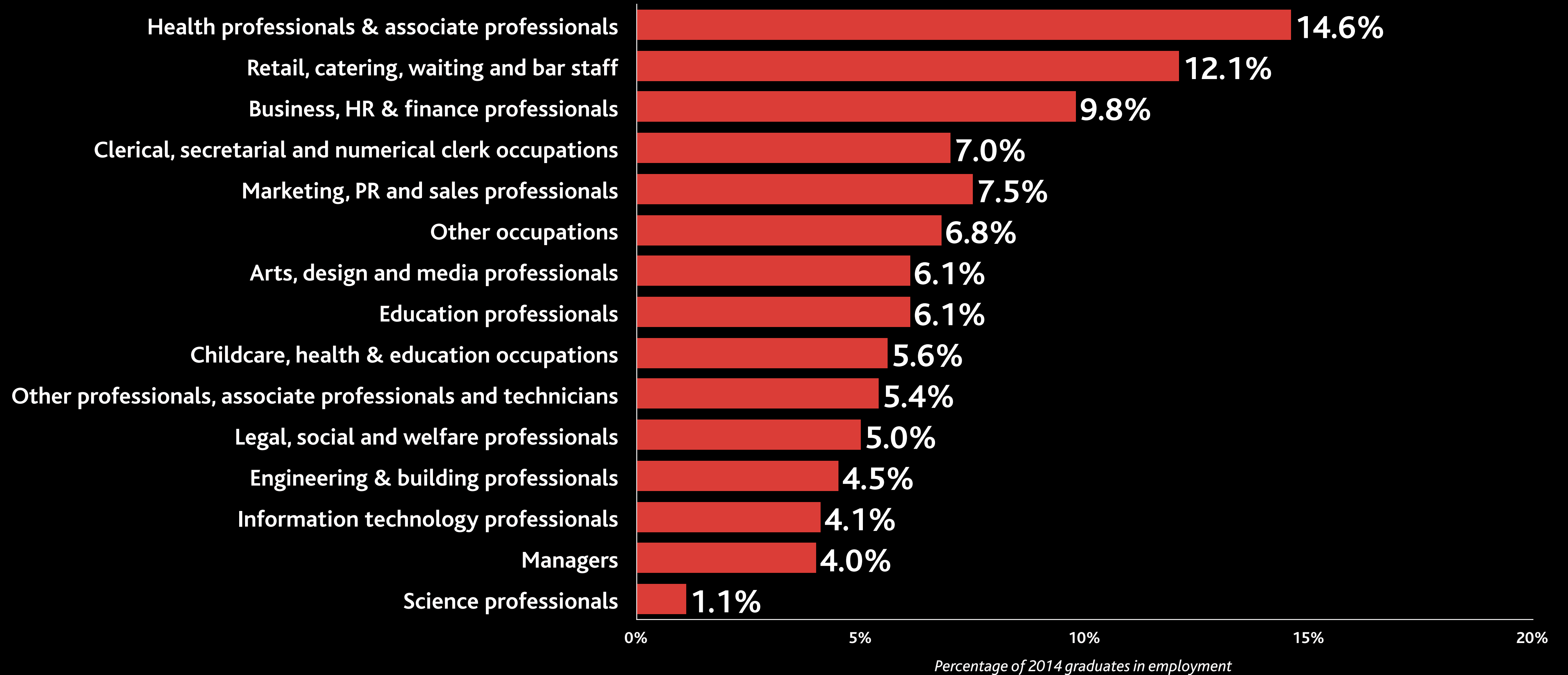

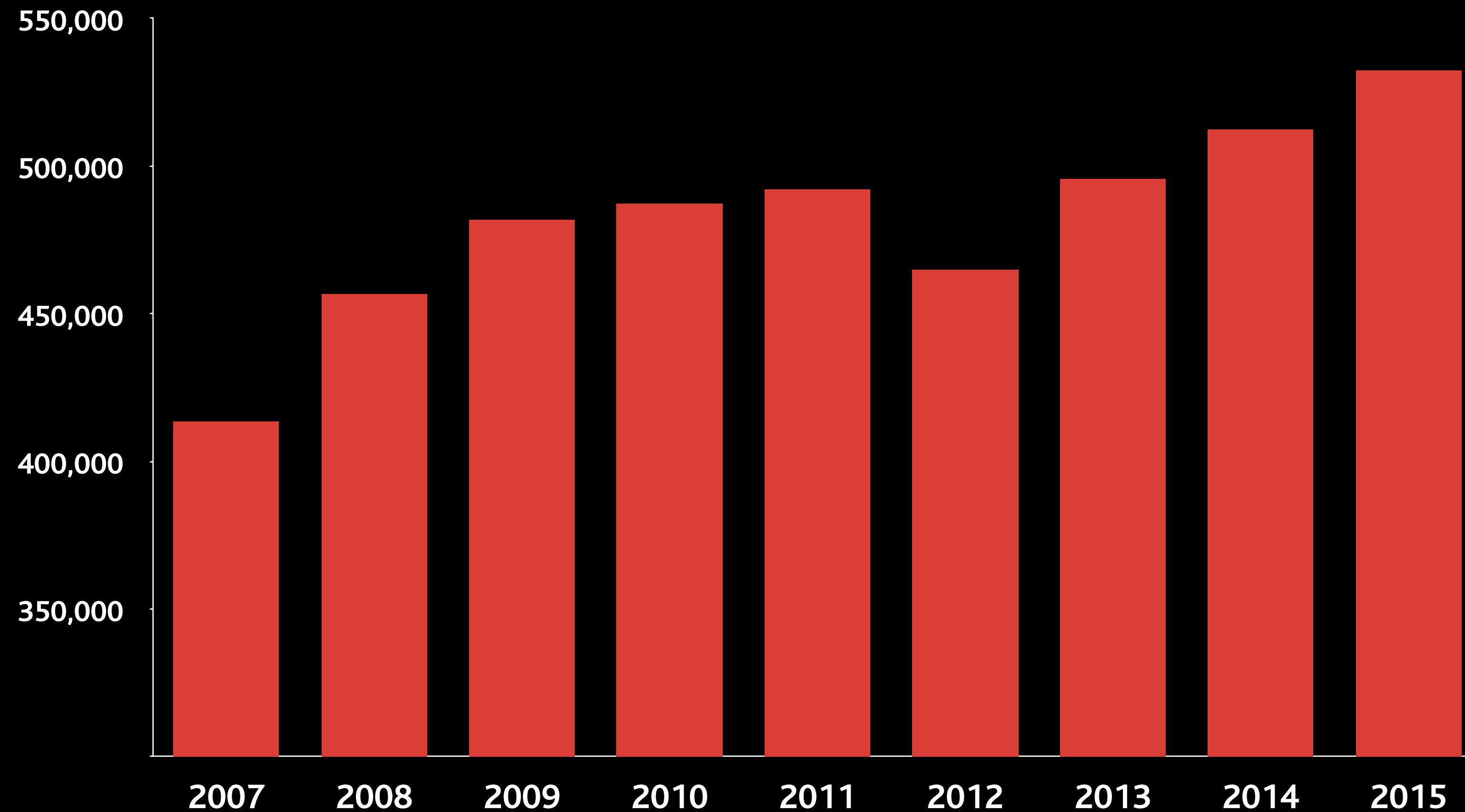

Where do Graduates Work?

- 70,000 places each year for doctors, nurses, teachers & vets
- 30,000-35,000 places annually on graduate development programmes at major national & international employers
- 75,000-100,000 direct entry places at organisations large and small
- Up to 400,000 graduates are expected to leave university in 2016

Value of Careers Guidance at School

- new research quantifies the benefit for teenagers who take part in careers talks
- 14-15 year olds who attended six careers talks earned £2,000-a-year more by age 26
- similar impact for 15-16 year olds if they found the careers talks helpful
